

# Death of suspect brings court case to an end

Deceased had threatened to kill his parents and siblings

Dubai: A case against an Emirati suspect, charged with threatening to kill his parents, brothers and sister, was dropped Wednesday after his death.

"The case against the suspect, K.M., has been dropped following his death," said the Dubai Court of First Instance's Presiding Judge Fahmi Mounir when he pronounced the decision in courtroom four.

K.M. was being prosecuted before the Court of First Instance facing charges of threatening to kill his father, mother, sister and two brothers because his mother refused to give him money.

Court records did not clarify as to where, why and when the defendant died.

Prosecutors accused the late suspect with verbally threatening to kill his 61-year-old father, 47-year-old mother, brothers and sister and when his family reported him to the police, he also cursed, threatened and assaulted two policemen.

## **Suspect shot**

Prosecution records said a police corporal shot the suspect, who was armed with a knife, in his right leg to let a police team restrain and arrest him.

The defendant denied his charges and pleaded innocent when he appeared in court.
