

Police detain three people for theft in Dubai companies

Dubai: Three Asians were arrested recently for theft of millions worth of items and cash from commercial establishments in Dubai.

Brigadier Khalil Ebrahim Al Mansouri, Director General of the Criminal Investigations Department of Dubai Police (CID), said that the first robbery took place in early July when a car spare parts company reported to the police about a theft from its safe which contained Dh945,000 along with cheques worth large amounts. Huge amounts of car spare parts were also missing. Many other such reports were filed with the Dubai Police during July with the latest taking place at the end of the month in Umm Al Rumoul area, said Brigadier Al Mansouri.

A safe was stolen from a company, which had Dh850,000, jewellery, cheques worth millions of dirhams and other important documents.

The CID deployed specialised units to study the cases and monitor certain areas in Dubai.

The suspects are detained and the cases were referred to the Public Prosecution for investigations.
