

Two held in 60kg haul of narcotics

Two suspects from a Gulf country held for the possession, abuse and trafficking of 60kg of narcotics

Dubai: Police say they have arrested two suspects from a Gulf country for the possession, abuse and trafficking of 60kg of narcotics.

Dubai Police said they arrested the first suspect on November 20 for narcotics possession and abuse.

The first suspect confessed to the activities of the second suspect who lived in Al Ain, police said. The accused said the other suspect had trafficked 60kg of heroin and hashish worth Dh600,000.

The second suspect, S.A., was arrested on December 4 and had confessed to trafficking 57kg of hashish which he hid on Al Thaid Road in Sharjah, and 3kg of heroin which he hid in his vehicle which was parked at Al Safer Mall in Ajman, police said.
